You can apply for an Empowerment Scholarship year round. Funding is given by the Department of Education Quarterly



#### WHAT IS THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AMOUNT?

The base scholarship award is **\$6000** for 1st-12th grade. This amount goes up to **\$30,000** depending on a child's learning or developmental disability

# WHO QUALIFIES?

- Preschool student with a disability (504/IEP/MET)
- K-12 student with a disability (504/IEP/MET)
- Student with an active-duty military parent
- Student with a parent killed in the line of duty
- Student with a parent who is legally blind, deaf, or hard of hearing
- Student is zoned for, and attends a D or F school
- Student who resides in a Native American reservation
- Student is a sibling of a current or previous recipient
- $\checkmark$  Student is a ward of the court
- Student was a previous ESA recipient

## C Do you apply Every year?

**No**, once you qualify for an ESA, you simply renew your contract each year until your child graduates from High School.
